

Example 1 IGFA Compliant Swordfish Deepdrop Rig (provided by Captain Charlie Albright)



IGFA Angling Rules, Equipment Regulations, Section C, Leader

The double line on all classes of tackle over 10 kilograms (20 pounds) shall be limited to 9.14 meters (30 feet).

The combined length of the double line and leader shall not exceed 12.19 meters (40 feet).

The full length of the leader and double line (if used), as well as at least 5 meters (16 feet, 4 inches) of the mainline or top-shot must be provided to the IGFA Tournament Representative for all weighed fish to qualify.


IGFA Class Braid (Spectra) Top-Shot

IGFA Compliant Swordfish Deepdrop Rig

(provided by Captain Charlie Albright)

Bluefin tuna rod converted to deep drop rod with 100 to 130-pound braid/spectra to braid/spectra 80 to 100-pound class braid/spectra top-shot.

NOTE: If there is enough space on the reel for the leader and more 80 to 100-pound class braid/spectra, then there will be less drag or friction from the water on the line. This allows for a more vertical presentation and provides a more accurate depth.





Bluefin tuna rod converted to deep drop rod with 100 to 130-pound braid/spectra to 100 to 130-pound IGFA class monofilament top-shot.
